



We'd like your views on future development in South Norfolk's villages

Between 7 June and 2 August, South Norfolk Council is consulting on a draft of its Village Clusters Housing Allocations Plan (VCHAP). This is a new Local Plan document that will allocate sites for housing growth in smaller villages across South Norfolk.

To ensure the ongoing vitality of South Norfolk's villages it is important that appropriate opportunities for sustainable development continue to be found. These villages have been grouped into 48 different clusters and our ambition is to distribute sites for growth across as many of the clusters as possible.

You can view and comment on sites that have currently been identified as Preferred Options, as well as those that have not been selected as preferred. Anyone wishing to put forward alternative areas of land for consideration will also be able to do so as part of this consultation.
